How to Support New Orleans (\$USD)

Uniforms

Children's T-Shirt – \$15

Arte Reviver takes great pride in its logo: our academies are the stars in the sky, but children are the sun. We simply would not exist were it not for our drive and passion to train children in the art of capoeira. A t-shirt is a marker of inclusion in our global Arte Reviver community.

Children's Abada – \$35

We wear white pants, or abada, in the tradition of the capoeira legend Mestre Bimba.

Complete Children's Uniform – \$50

Provide a child with the appropriate athletic wear for capoeira, and pride in their appearance during class and in their community.

Instruments

Agogo – \$50

The *agogo* are two small gourd bells, played in a one-two-three rhythm.

Berimbau – \$100

The *berimbau* leads the *roda* where we play capoeira.

Pandeiro – \$150

The *pandeiro* is a hand drum played with the rhythm of the capoeiristas' clapping.

Atabaque – \$400

The *atabaque* is a standing drum, with a rhythm that changes subtly with every song.

Bateria – \$700

The complete musical line-up is called the *bateria*, but everyone participates by singing.

Scholarship

Children's Tuition – \$85 / month

Tuition for a child covers instruction in the martial art, music, and dance of capoeira at our Mid-City academy. Give this gift once, or on a recurring basis.
